Home - School - Child Agreement 2020-2021

The Home-School agreement is seen as a good way of promoting good relationships outside of school and inside school for the benefit of pupils. It sets out clearly the responsibilities and expectations of the school, the parents and the child.

The school will:

- promote high standards of work and behavior through high quality teaching;
- provide a balanced education within a broad curriculum in a Christian ethos;
- encourage children to care for their surroundings, the equipment and resources they use, and to adopt a caring and respectful approach to all others;
- encourage children to do their best at all times and celebrate their successes;
- provide a happy, caring and safe environment for learning;
- keep children safe and promote healthy living;
- deliver the National Curriculum/Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum;
- give details to parents of their child's learning and progress at through regular meetings and reports, both formally and informally;
- provide opportunities for the school and parents to work closely together;
- set, mark and/or monitor homework assignments;
- ensure that the school will be an open, welcoming and caring place for all pupils, staff, parents and other visitors.

The family will:

- show by example that you support the school in setting high standards, and treat all adults and children courteously;
- make sure your child comes to school regularly, safely, on time, refreshed, alert, correctly dressed and ready to learn and take part in school activities and to phone school before 9am if your child will be absent due to illness;
- make sure that your child is collected on time at the end of the day or at the end of the after school club session;
- encourage your child to aim at the highest standards in all aspects of school life;
- take an active and supportive interest in your child's work and progress, including attending Parent/Teacher consultations and attend any special events in which your child is involved;
- avoid taking holidays during school term time unless absolutely essential;
- contact the school as concerns or problems arise that might affect your child's learning or behaviour;
- support the authority and discipline of the school, helping your child to achieve maturity, self-discipline and self-control and abide by the guidance provided in the school prospectus;
- encourage your child to consider and respect the feelings and property of other people both in the school and the wider community;
- encourage your child to complete reading and homework tasks to the best of his/her ability as well as ensuring your child has adequate support in completing homework tasks;
- Work in partnership with the school in all aspects of your child's education and welfare.

Together we will:

- Address any special needs;
- Encourage children to keep the school rules and their class Golden Rules;
- Uphold the Christian values of our school;
- Support children's learning and development to help them achieve their best.

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Please read the Home - School - Child Agreement overleaf and sign the relevant section to demonstrate you agree and will undertake to follow the school rules and procedures as well as explaining the importance of the agreement to your child. Please keep your copy of the agreement and return this signed cover sheet to the school as soon as possible. This copy is kept confidentially for the time that your child attends Cameley CEVC Primary School. If the agreement is broken it may be appropriate for the Headteacher to ask to meet with parents.
